

Duro-Polish and Duro-Polish Plus are a synthetic polymer floor polishes that provide an, ultra-high gloss, slip resistant finish that is scuff and scratch resistant. Low molecular weight allows deep penetration and the unique metal cross-linked chemistry allows for easy removal. In addition, Duro-Polish Plus contains a fluoropolymer additive that provides stain protection from water and oil-based stains.

CLEANING DO'S AND DON'TS

- DO use a neutral based detergent cleaner such as ZEP Commercial Neutral Floor Cleaner
 Concentrate, diluted according to manufacturer's instructions for periodic cleaning. The use of any other floor cleaning products should be test applied before full scale cleaning to ensure compatibility.
- DO clean and sweep more in the winter time. Salt, sand, and gravel tracked in from outside cause more wear and tear on the surface.
- DO wipe up spills and stains immediately, even on a Duro-Polish Plus treated surface to prevent permanent staining or concrete etching.
- DON'T use ammonia or any amine containing detergents to clean a Duro-Polish or Duro-Polish Plus treated floor. This will cause irreparable damage, necessitating stripping, followed by reapplication.
- DON'T perform regular maintenance with aggressive pads such as diamond impregnated polishing pads.
 The use of aggressive polish pads will cause fading and loss of stain protection.
- DON'T clean or polish with wax.

TOUCH UPS

Dry buffing with a white felt polishing pad restores gloss and removes scratches and scuff marks.

REAPPLICATION

- Frequency of reapplication depends on use conditions.
 Floors treated with Duro-Nox and Duro-Polish generally become glossier through use over time.
- To restore the high gloss appearance, clean the floor thoroughly and apply a light coat of Duro-Polish or Duro-Polish Plus following the original application procedures.
